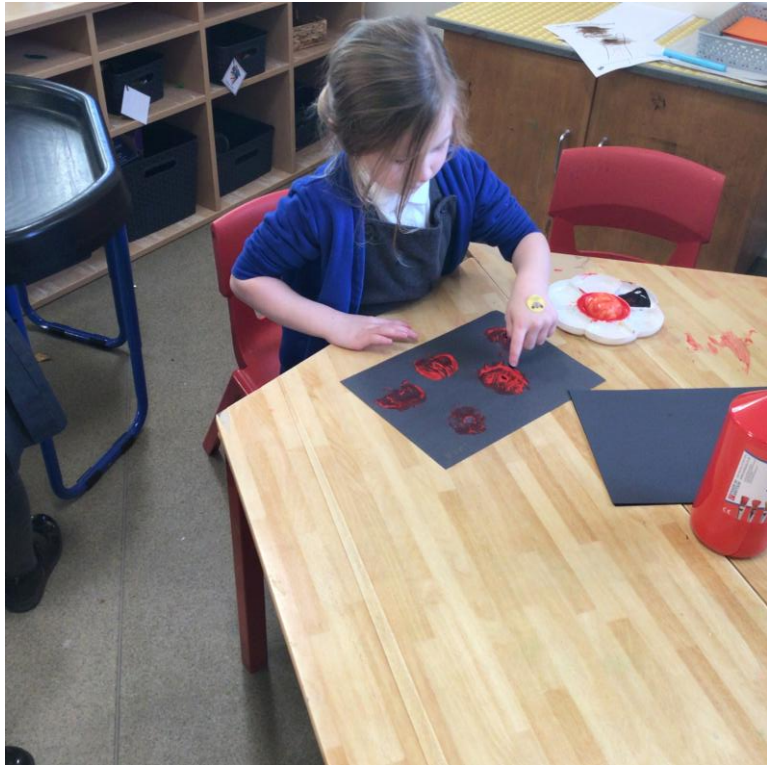
OUR SCHOOL DAY

- Our morning session runs from 8:30-11:30am

- Children who have been offered a place for 30 hours will need to bring a packed lunch.
- There is an additional charge for the lunch hour or you can collect your child for lunch and then bring them back for the afternoon session.
- Our doors open from 11:20am and 3:20pm for pick up.
- Please let us know if someone different is collecting your child.
- You will be asked to provide a password – All About Me booklet.

TRANSITION

- Children will have a staggered start to Nursery.
- Building from an hour, to two hours, to a full morning/afternoon and then a full day for 30 hours children.
- If your child struggles to settle we will call you and arrange a further staggered start.
- We will contact you if your child becomes upset. Often once you have gone they settle and are distracted by playing.

SNACK AND MILK

- Children are offered a glass of milk or water and a piece of fruit during each session.
- We ask for a weekly donation of 50p to cover costs of our Welly Walk snack, playdough, baking, craft resources and other toys/games. This can be paid weekly or £3 each half term (please send in a labelled envelope).
- We also have a Friday tuck shop – send 50p on a Friday in named envelope or purse/wallet.

CLOTHING

- Practical clothing is best.
- Loose bands on trousers.
- Sensible shoes for indoors and outdoors.
- Coats appropriate for the weather.
- A pair of wellies to keep at school (name inside).
- Names in everything!
- Please send in a bag of spare clothing (including socks/tights!)

COMMUNICATION

- We use Class Dojo to communicate with parents/carers.
- You will be given a QR code to scan and join our school.
- You can message staff.
- Key notices, dates and events will be published on Class Dojo either via the class page or the whole school page.
- We use Tapestry as our online learning journey. We will add photos of your child's learning. You can also add photos.



ILLNESS

- If your child is ill please inform the office as soon as possible.
- If your child has sickness and/or diarrhoea please keep them off school for 48 hours after the last attack.

- Please inform us as soon as possible if your child has a special need, speech and language concern or any medical needs or allergies.
