Be brave

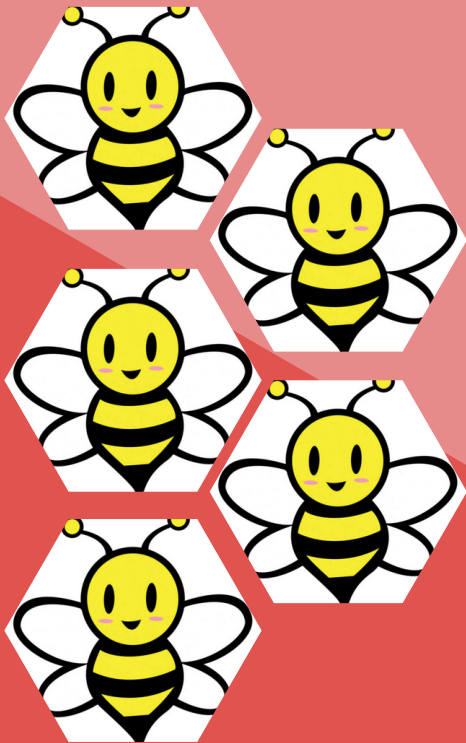
We try our best by showing resilience and giving everything our best shot.
